

Easter Chick – Knitted Eyelet lace Pattern

- Materials:
 - Double Knitting wool
 - 1 pair 4mm (8) knitting needles
 - 1.4 metres of Knitting in Lace
 - Small amount of stuffing for the head
 - Ribbon for trimming
 - Small pieces of black felt for the eyes and orange felt for the beak.



Knit in garter stitch throughout

- Method:
 - Cast on 20 stitches and knit 2 rows
 - Increase at both ends of alternate rows until 30 stitches.
 - **** Meanwhile ****
 - Knit in lace on the 1st increase row, then every 4th row until you have 30 stitches.
 - Knit one row
 - Cast off 7 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows (16st)
 - Knit 1 row lace
 - Knit 8 rows
 - Knit 2 together across next row
 - Thread wool through all stitches and fasten off.
 - Stuff the head. Sew black stitches for eyes and orange felt for the beak.
 - Trim as desired.
 - Fill the bottom with a cream egg or with plastic bauble egg used as a gift holder



N.B. To knit in lace – hold lace at back of work, and incorporate lace by putting needle through stitching in normal way and then through a slot in the lace. Bring the needles back in the normal way. One slot for one stitch.
